# Grantwriting

for the INDIVIDUAL INVESTIGATOR

**A 3-Credit hour online course\* from 1/13 to 4/27/20  
for MDs, Research Scientists, Faculty, & PhDs**

In this 15-week course you will draft a grant application on your project, from specific aims to preparation of a full proposal package for submission, with the NIH R01 as exemplar. The process of organizing collaborators, mentors, and advisory committees and negotiating those relationships will also be examined.

The course number is CTS 6266 and the Course Registration Number (CRN) is 76751

You will need to apply to GW as a non-degree seeking student, enroll in the course for Spring registration starting November 25 and, use your tuition benefits to pay for the course, if eligible.

1. Apply to GW as a non-degree student. Individuals who wish to take courses at GW without entering a degree program may apply online for non-degree admission through the Office of Non-Degree Students at <https://nondegree.gwu.edu/about-non-degree>. You will be a general study student and can apply online here <https://nondegree.gwu.edu/general-study-applicants>. You can apply a month before course registration starts for the semester. 2. Register for the course here <https://registrar.gwu.edu/how-register>. Once you are admitted, then you will need to complete a registration transaction form. This form will need to be filled out by you as the student and then, signed by the Program Director (contact information below). Lastly, you would then take the registration transaction form and give it to your Non-Degree Student Advisor.
